Dept of CSE organized two day workshop on Hands on workshop on "raspberry Pi" on 22th Feb. & 25th Feb.2019. Rasperry Pi is the name of a series of single-board computers made by the Rasperry Pi Foundation, a UK charity that aims to educate people in computing and create easier access to computing education.

The Rasperry Pi launched in 2012, and there have been several iterations and variations released since then. The original Pi had a single-core 700MHz CPU and just 256MB RAM, and the latest model has a quad-core CPU clocking in at over 1.5GHz, and 4GB RAM. All over the world, people use the Rasperry Pi to learn programming skills, build hardware projects, do home automation, implement Kubernetes clusters and Edge computing, and even use them in industrial applications.

35 students attended the workshop and successfully completed the hands on experiments.
