"Post Budget Session on Union Budget 2024-25 organized by PHDCCI, Delhi"

Date: 31 July 2024

Introduction:

The Chief Guest for the session was Shri Sanjay Malhotra, IAS, Revenue Secretary, Ministry of Finance, Government of India. Shri Sanjay Malhotra and other dignitaries and experts engaged in discussions on budget's strengths and weaknesses, and explored alternative policy options.
