## **Generic Preventive Measures/Covid-19 appropriate Behaviour:**

The following public health measures are to be followed to reduce the risk of Covid-19 by all (faculty members, employees, students and visitors) at all times:

- i. Physical distancing to be followed.
- ii. Use of face covers/masks is must and mandatory for all.
- iii. Frequent hand washing with soap(for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty. Use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers(for at least 20 seconds) can be done wherever feasible.
- iv. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing of used tissues properly.
- v. Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest.
- vi. Spitting shall be strictly prohibited.
- vii. Installation & use of Aarogya Setu App is advised wherever feasible.
- viii. Students should carry, exam related documents, admit card, ID card etc., face mask, water bottle, hand sanitiser etc.
- ix. Only asymptomatic staff and students shall be allowed inside the examination hall as per the guidelines and face cover/mask has to be worn at all times inside the examination centre.
- x. On completion of the exam, the Students are permitted to move out in an orderly manner.

## COVID-19: IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS APPEARING FOR OFFLINE (Pen & Paper Mode) EXAMINATIONS

- 1. Students are required to follow the rules, regulations and guidelines of IGDTUW; Local Authorities, State Government and Government of India especially related to COVID-19 as issued from time to time.
- 2. Students should maintain social distancing while commuting to and from the examination centre and from the time of entry at examination centre till the exit from the examination centre.
- 3. Students should carry soap/hand-sanitiser of up to 50 ml in transparent bottle, face mask, gloves and water in transparent bottle for personal use.
- 4. Student should not share personal items like mask, gloves, water bottle etc.
- 5. It is mandatory to wear a face mask and gloves properly at all times.
- 6. Spitting is strictly prohibited.
- 7. It is mandatory to undergo thermal scanning before entering examination centre.

- 8. Students with high temperature or other symptoms of COVID-19 will not be permitted to enter the examination centre and take examination.
- 9. Student should wash hands/ use hand sanitizer before entering examination hall.
- 10. Student should maintain social distancing from other people at all times in the examination centre.
- 11. Students should avoid speaking face to face as far as possible, if any Student does so it will be at her own risk.
- 12. Student should avoid using lifts and avoid touching or leaning to handrails, walls etc.
